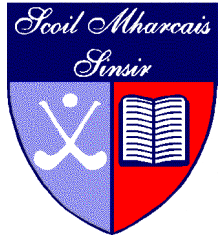

This will be a very practical course aimed at giving you the skills to work with your children in a Restorative way. It will deepen your understanding of the R.P. work we do in schools.

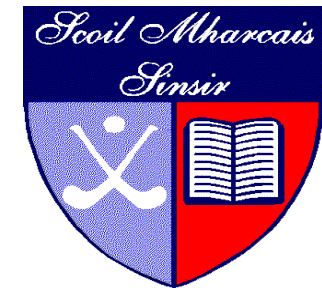
